He or she is a trusted person, who is caring and provides positive solutions and support to their mentee. As a mentor, you will be asked to be a stable and positive influence and represent what an adult role model should be. Volunteer mentors are matched with a child, grades K-6th, in the WSR area. School-based mentors meet with their assigned mentee for 30 minutes a week on school grounds, during school hours. Mentors are asked to commit to mentoring with AIM for 18 months.
